Meeting Minutes **September 3, 2020 @ 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM** **Virtual Meeting via Zoom**

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by President Jeremy Barousse.

We had a public safety presentation by Captain Jason Ta of the San Jose Police Department. He reported that most of the BLM protests have been peaceful. They are encouraging Neighborhood Watch groups to assist with keeping our neighborhoods safe. They are still short handed, but are actively recruiting, and also plan to hire additional Community Service Officers. For more info: crimemapping.com/sjpd.org

Land Use Committee – The complex at the Arcadia Ballpark property will be called Evergreen Circle. The . Costco there is a business facility – they have business products and some grocery, but no clothing, no RX. The Buddhist Temple is attempting to have the property rezoned. The committee will continue to monitor this. There are discussions to remove Reid-Hillview Airport and put in housing. The property is part of the County, not the City.

Evergreen Elementary School District – They are totally distance learning. They will continue to evaluate this as the COVID situation changes. Currently there are no layoffs. They have declining enrollment – 9,500 students down from 13,000.

The next meeting will be Thursday, October 1st. The League of Women Voters will explain the measures and propositions on the upcoming November ballot.
